#### 1. Definition of Terms

- 1.1. Resources In the library context, resources refer to journals, books, or electronic databases. They come in both physical and electronic forms (Operational Definition).
- 1.2. Document Delivery Service The document delivery service processes articles and book chapter requests from the journals, books, e-resources and other materials available only in UP Diliman Libraries. (Operational Definition).
- 1.3. Electronic resources Electronic resources (e-resources) are materials in digital format that may be accessed electronically. They may refer to paid subscriptions to electronic books (eBooks) and journals (referred in this document as Subscribed E-Resources), or open-access resources curated by the library. (Operational Definition).
- 1.4. *Physical resources* Physical resources are books, monographs, periodicals, thesis and dissertations, microfilms and other physical materials that may be accessed by visiting the library where the collection is located (Operational Definition).
- 1.5. Local databases Local databases refer to databases hosted by the University Library where bibliographic information of library resources can be searched. Some of these databases also host the full-text of library resources (Operational Definition).
- 1.6. Open Educational Resources Open Educational Resources (OER) are teaching, learning and research materials in any medium digital or otherwise that reside in the public domain or have been released under an open license that permits no-cost access, use, adaptation and redistribution by others with no or limited restrictions (UNESCO).
- 1.7. Copyright Copyright refers to the protection given to intellectual works. In simpler terms, copyright means that the original creators of work and anyone they give the authorization to have the exclusive right to reproduce the latter (Republic Act No. 8293).

- 1.8. Fair Use Fair use refers to what the law allows in terms of using someone's intellectual property. Under fair use, the use of copyrighted work such as for classroom instruction, the conduct of a study, and other related purposes is not copyright infringement (Republic Act No. 8293).
- 1.9. Licensing Agreement A licensing agreement outlines the acceptable terms by which a party can use another work/ownership. Using electronic resources, access, and reproduction are governed by the agreement between the library and the vendor (Operational Definition).
- 1.10. Reproduction In the context of fair use of educational resources, reproduction refers to any duplication or reproduction of resources for classroom instruction and research (Republic Act No. 8293).

  - 3.2.1. Creation of an index or pathfinder which will serve as a guide to what has been curated or the available OER resources in the library.
  - 3.2.2. Creation of a one-stop platform for each department/college containing collection of readings for each course/topic. Faculty members are encouraged to contribute or build such collections.
  - 3.2.3. Initiate marketing campaign infographics, videos, webinars, etc containing instructions on how OER works, etc.
  - 3.2.4. Students may be taught on how to curate OERs as an online portfolio through the CU Learning Management System, or reference management systems (i.e. Zotero, Mendeley, EndNote, etc)

  - 4.1.4. Faculty members may also request to reproduce certain parts of the material (subject to existing rules on copyright and fair use) through the Document Delivery Service. See Section 4.5 for the procedures.

#### 4.2. Access to Electronic Resources

- 4.2.1. Electronic resources, such as journals and articles, ebooks, and other digital materials, may be accessed on-campus when connected to the UP Diliman Network (DilNet). Links to these electronic resources are found in the University Library website (<a href="https://mainlib.upd.edu.ph">https://mainlib.upd.edu.ph</a>). When accessing off-campus, you may visit <a href="https://ezproxy.upd.edu.ph">https://ezproxy.upd.edu.ph</a> and log in using your DILNET account. To request log-in access to EZProxy, please refer to Section 4.4.
- 4.2.2. Microfilms may be converted to PDF for greater access and readability. For conversion requests, please send an email to <a href="mailto:libraryinfo.updiliman@up.edu.ph">libraryinfo.updiliman@up.edu.ph</a> and indicate the name of the material, year of publication, and coverage of the conversion request. Refer to <a href="mailto:Tuklas">Tuklas</a> for the bibliographic details of the material.
- 4.2.3. In cases wherein a scholarly article or resource is not available in our collection; please send an email to <a href="libraryinfo.updiliman@up.edu.ph">libraryinfo.updiliman@up.edu.ph</a> for assistance in finding alternative sources. However, if a particular resource is not accessible and may only be used after copyright permission is sought, the requesting faculty member will need to ask permission directly from the copyright owner. Furthermore, they may request an endorsement letter from the University Librarian before doing so.

#### 4.3. Terms of Use

- 4.3.1. The use of online database content is governed by copyright and vendor license agreements.
- 4.3.2. Contents are restricted for use in academic research and classroom instruction only. Avoid sharing resources with people outside the university domain.

- 4.3.3. Systematic downloading (or excessive downloading of data) of resources is strictly PROHIBITED. The system can monitor the downloading of full-text content and may lead to suspension of access credentials.
- 4.3.4. The University Library may suspend Library privileges and revoke accounts of patrons found to have violated these policies.
- 4.3.5. The Information Services and Instruction Section of the University Library manages only multi-disciplinary e-resources, including Taylor and Francis Online, JSTOR, and Project MUSE. College and Unit Libraries may have different terms of use, depending on the licensing agreements with the vendors. Please make sure to check with the concerned unit library to avoid any breach.

- 4.5.2. 10% is a middle ground that seeks to strike a balance between author/ publisher interests, and the academic and research needs of UP faculty. As of this writing, these are the documented numbers for reproducing materials by other respected library institutions: (1) UST Miguel de Benavides Library—"not more than 5% of a book" (FAQ on Copyright and Library Services <a href="https://www.facebook.com/ustmdblib/photos/pcb.2005549286245819/2005546232912791">https://www.facebook.com/ustmdblib/photos/pcb.2005549286245819/2005546232912791</a>); (2) Biblioteca Nacional de España—"up to a maximum of 20% of a book" (Document reproduction <a href="http://www.bne.es/en/Servicios/ReproduccionDocumentos/">http://www.bne.es/en/Servicios/ReproduccionDocumentos/</a>). While we are waiting for definitive legal guidance regarding fair use, the UPD Library will keep on exercising its mandate to the UP community to provide the best possible access to the information that they need in support of instruction, research and extension.
- 4.5.3. Requests for e-copy of a whole book in the physical collection will only be granted under all of the following conditions:

- 4.5.3.1. The faculty member affirms that they will only use the book in accordance with the conditions stipulated in Section 188 of the Republic Act No. 8293 as amended: "Not for profit", "For purposes of study or research", and "Copies are not available with the publisher"; and
- 4.5.3.2. Access to the electronic copy of the book (via shared Drive) will be limited to viewing only (no downloading/printing) and will be revoked every end of the semester/midyear.

#### 6. Assistance on Requesting Permission to Use Copyrighted Materials for Course Packs

- 6.1. It is understood that the end-user (i.e. the faculty member) will be the one responsible for requesting permission from copyright holders (i.e. authors or publishers) to use copyrighted materials for their course packs. This is because the end-user is in the best position to justify the purpose or intended use of a copyrighted material (e.g., teaching, research).
- 6.2. The following assistance may be provided by the Library for facilitating copyright permission requests for use in course packs:

- 6.2.1. Provision of contact details of publishers,
- 6.2.2. Template for permission request letters, and
- 6.2.3. Endorsement from the University Librarian (for resources at the Main Library) or the Head Librarian of the College Library (for resources available in the College/Unit Libraries).
- 6.3. The following are advised as a workflow for the faculty members in ensuring that materials being included in course packs are compliant with its license.
  - 6.3.1. Determine the license or terms of use of the material or database.
    - 6.3.1.1. Works in the *Public Domain* are free to distribute and reproduce. Examples of such works are government works and works which copyright has expired as stipulated in the Intellectual Property Code.
    - 6.3.1.2. Works under a *Creative Commons License* can be distributed and reproduced for non-commercial use, provided that there is attribution to the original work. Learn more about attributing materials under a *Creative Commons License* at https://wiki.creativecommons.org/wiki/Best\_practices\_for\_attribution.
    - 6.3.1.3. *Copyrighted* materials, without permission from the copyright holder, cannot be reproduced and distributed.
  - 6.3.2. If distributing a copy of the copyrighted material through the course pack is not desired (i.e. uploading PDF copy in the LMS or reproducing copies in printed modules), a direct link to authorized copy on the Internet (e.g. publisher's website or library database) may be included in the course pack.
  - 6.3.3. If distributing a copy of the copyrighted material through the course pack is desired, a written permission request must be sent to the copyright holder. The assistance of the concerned Library may be sought.

#### 7. Acquisition/Procurement of Resources Required for Remote Learning

- 7.1. The University Library Diliman welcomes requests and suggestions from the members of the faculty for the selection, evaluation and acquisitions of materials in support of their research and teaching programs. Librarians review requests and if evaluated to be within the scope and level of need as defined in its collection development policy should be given high priority for acquisitions. (University Library Collection Development Policy 2012, p.13)
- 7.2. Selection decisions for general reference materials are made by the Information Services and Instruction Section, in coordination with the college/unit libraries. Large purchase decisions are made after consultation with the Library Executive Staff Committee.

  Reference resources are selected for inclusion in the collection based on content and recency, rather than the format or value of the materials. The general reference collection

- is managed based on principles of maximum utility to the largest number of library users. (University Library Collection Development Policy 2012, p.8)
- 7.3. Specialized or subject reference collection is developed to provide information in different subject fields and disciplines. Selection of this type of material shall be made by the college/unit libraries. (University Library Collection Development Policy 2012, p.8)
- 7.4. As stated in Section 9 of the University Library Organic Act of 1991, the College Library Committee shall recommend the acquisitions of books, continuing resources and other library materials based on the needs of the College to ensure a well-balanced collection development program. It shall adopt policies consistent with university rules and regulations to meet the College's special needs. It shall assist in acquiring additional library resources including funds, books, equipment, etc. and serve as a link between the library and the faculty or staff of the College.
