Its primary functions include acquiring, organizing, and disseminating information resources needed by the students, faculty, and staff.

Collection

The library has a vast collection on Asian studies, which consists of print and non-print materials in English and Asian languages.

The collection is divided into the four (4) geographic areas of concentration of the Center's academic and research programs namely, Southeast Asia, East Asia, South Asia, and West Asia. The collection is focused on Asian socio-cultural, economic, and political subject areas. There is also a general collection of print materials of various topics related to other countries around the world.



RESOURCE ON DEMAND (ROD) SERVICE/BOOK REQUEST

The Resource On Demand (ROD) service is open to all bonafide students, faculty, REPS, and staff of the University of the Philippines. They can access and read book chapters or articles from journals, books, e-resources, and other materials. These documents are scanned and can be picked-up in person or sent electronically via email.

Only a portion equivalent to 10% or one (1) chapter of the resource material is scanned. Access link (view only) will be given to the requester. This access link will expire at the end of the semester as stated in the Guidelines and Assistance for Faculty and Students to Access Library Resources.
