What is remote learning?

Courses in the First Semester AY 2020-2021 will be delivered <u>remotely</u>.


Remote Learning ≠ Online Learning.
Remote learning may or may not be online.

TRADITIONAL



Teachers and Learners meet in a **physical classroom** at **set times** every day.

REMOTE LEARNING



Teachers and Learners are **geographically** or **physically separated** from each other. They do not meet in a physical classroom.

Remote Learning is synonymous with Distance Education.

Which type of learner are you?

Has a laptop/desktop computer/tablet/ smartphone and stable internet access



Has a laptop/desktop computer/tablet/ smartphone but no internet access



No laptop/desktop computer/tablet/ smartphone and no internet access



Remote Learning has **different modes of delivery** to **suit the needs** of **all types of learners**.

Remote Learning is **Resource-Based Learning** – It involves **use of** education resources and various media.

Modes of delivery* in remote learning

SYNCHRONOUS (real-time)

- lectures, webinars and teleconferences using such platforms as Zoom, Google Meet

ASYNCHRONOUS (non-real-time)

- printed learning materials
- **recorded lectures** (audio or video)
- **text-based** (basic email, FB messenger, Viber group, etc.)
- online discussion boards in different platforms (UP's Learning Management Systems (e.g. UVLE, VLE), Canvas, Google Classroom, Edmodo etc.)
- other interactive multimedia

*The mode of delivery will be agreed-upon by the Student and the Faculty.

Course Packs

Course packs will be available to all students in a course before the start of classes.

What is inside a COURSE PACK?

- A course guide with a detailed syllabus of the course
- Learning resources (e.g. readings, multimedia resources like video lectures, other content resources)
- Activity guides
- Assignment guides

The COURSE PACK will be in different formats:

- As **online materials uploaded to the course site** like UVLE
- As digital files in a flash drive/USB
- As printed materials to be sent via courier or other means

Things to remember:

Remote Learning is <u>GUIDED INDEPENDENT</u>
<u>LEARNING</u>. You will learn independently but will still be guided by your professor/instructor.

Whatever type of learner you are, you can participate in Remote Learning.
